



PRIVACY POLICY OF THE PRICEWATERHOUSECOOPERS LLP REGISTRATION SOFTWARE

Effective Date: Wednesday, February 16, 2005

The PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software is provided by PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP, a registered limited liability partnership formed under the laws of the State of Delaware. The personal data you provide when you register using the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software will be controlled by PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP. Data may also be used by the PricewaterhouseCoopers network which includes any entity which carries on business under a name which includes all or part of the PricewaterhouseCoopers name, is a direct or indirect affiliate or subsidiary of a PricewaterhouseCoopers entity or its otherwise within (or associated or connected with an entity within) or is a correspondent firm of the worldwide network of PricewaterhouseCoopers firms, where "entities" or an "entity" includes partnerships, firms, corporations or other entities wherever located. "We" or "us" in this Privacy Statement means, in relation to your personal data, the PricewaterhouseCoopers entity that is the controller of that personal data.

"You" in this Privacy Statement means you as an individual, rather than any legal entity (such as your employer) which you may represent when you register for the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software.

1. Information we have about you

"Personal data" means information about you and/or third parties (where required by law, a third party could be a legal entity represented by you, e.g., where you submit data to us about your employer or a client company).

We receive personal data about you that is not available publicly. This information is received from a variety of sources, including:

- Information you provide directly to us, such as: your name, email address, mailing address,, title, company, phone and fax number, hotel reservation preferences (i.e., check-in and check-out dates, hotel accommodation special needs, room preferences, dietary needs, guest names), conference workshop attendance preferences, method of payment (credit card, check, cash, etc.), and credit card information (type, number, expiration date, name on card, address and phone number of card holder).

If you decide to register and obtain services or information using the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software (or if a legal entity which you represent has already registered and you log in

to the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software), you may be asked to fill in certain boxes with information about yourself or others. You do not have to fill in the "optional" boxes - if you don't, we will still register you or process your order or question but it is always helpful for us to receive this optional data as it may help us to understand your business needs. You must fill in the "mandatory" boxes marked in bold red as otherwise we may not be able to register you or process your order or question. We will only ever collect, hold, process, use, communicate and/or disclose such personal data, whether optional or not, in accordance with this Privacy Statement.

If you are acting as an intermediary or otherwise on behalf of a third party or supply us with information regarding a third party (such as your employer or a client company), you undertake that you are an authorized representative or agent of such third party and that you have obtained all necessary consents from such third party to the collection, processing, use and disclosure by us of their personal data. Because we are collecting the third party's data from you, you undertake to make the third party aware of all matters listed in this Privacy Statement, preferably by distributing a copy of this statement to them or by referring them to our website.

We do not generally seek to collect sensitive data, beyond what is needed to register you for the conference, through the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software. If we do seek to collect such data we will ask you to consent to the uses we propose to make of the data. By providing us with unsolicited sensitive data you consent to our using those data, subject to applicable law, for the purposes set out below.

2. Use of Information

We may process and use personal information collected via the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software or otherwise in relation to the registration software for the following purposes:

- to register you for the conference;
- to process your credit card information for payment;
- to operate the site (log files of your activity are maintained within the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software and are retained for the minimum period necessary for our web site operations -- log files are maintained to validate the integrity of each transaction and are kept confidential for normal operations unless required, in case of a dispute or as required by law);
- to monitor performance and activity statistics in the aggregate and to assist in maintaining the performance of the site and to help enhance operating effectiveness to provide information products and services to you at your request to update our records and databases to improve the personalization of our services for you;
- and/or send you related information which may be of interest to you. If you do not wish to receive any additional information or communications from us, please send email to meetpwc@seeucorp.com.

The PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software may also collect certain personally identifying information if a user contacts our customer support service. This information is used solely for the purpose of enhancing the customer support experience for individual users and is not used for any other purpose.

Our right to disclose the information is limited by our Code of Conduct, applicable law, and the Code of Professional Conduct of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA). Where appropriate, information provided by us to employees, affiliates and non-affiliated third parties who perform services for us, is subject to contractual agreements which prohibit these parties from disclosing or using the information other than for the purposes for which the information was disclosed.

3. Protection of Information

We maintain reasonable physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards in compliance with applicable laws and regulations to protect your non-public personal information. We have implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security in order to protect personally identifying information from loss, misuse, alteration or destruction, but the nature of the Internet is of course such that the data may flow over networks without appropriate security measures and may be accessed and used by unauthorized persons.

The PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software use secure socket layer technology for the protection of user registration information submitted through the Internet. PricewaterhouseCoopers employee access is limited to authorized personnel for maintenance, hosting, and operating purposes only, and who are under a duty to maintain the confidentiality of personally identifying information.

Please note that this Privacy Statement only covers the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software and does not regulate the privacy practices of other web sites which may be accessible through or linked to the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software.

4. Parties to whom we disclose information:

The data will only be disclosed to certain types of staff within PricewaterhouseCoopers entities (i.e., staff whose job it is to process your enquiries and orders or otherwise to administer the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software and those staff involved in the provision of services and products which may be of interest to you) and they will only process the data for the purposes identified in this Privacy Statement.

Personal data will also, subject to applicable law, be disclosed:

- To other entities within the PricewaterhouseCoopers network
- To data processors, suppliers or providers of goods or services, such as processing your credit card charges (but only for the purposes of processing your request for conference registration and/or accommodations, services or information)
- Where such disclosure is required by law through subpoena, search warrant or other forms of legal process

In some situations, you may submit personal data via the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software directly to third parties who supply services to PricewaterhouseCoopers entities in connection with the registration software (such as hosting the website or processing credit card details, among others). These entities will process personal data pursuant to this Privacy Statement".

5. Are personal data transferred to another country?

Because of the international nature of the service provided by the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software, and the nature of PricewaterhouseCoopers' activities, personal data may, subject to applicable law, be transferred internationally to other PricewaterhouseCoopers entities world-wide for the purposes described above.

This may mean that personal data are transferred to countries, such as the United States where the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software' servers are located, which do not provide legal protection of personal data equivalent to that in the country from which you are accessing the site.

By using the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software, you are explicitly consenting to the transfer of your personal information to other countries as described in this PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software Privacy Statement.

6. How can I access or change my personal data or withdraw my consent?

You are entitled to request access to and correct all your personal data collected by us via the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software, as well as to require us to delete your personal data if you no longer want us to process it. You may have additional rights provided by applicable laws.

7. How long are personal data retained?

We will keep your personal data only as long as required to operate the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software and provide the full scope of services offered to users. The "full scope of services" primarily means registering you for the conference you select, and retaining your contact and attendance records for potential offerings in the future. The username and Acceptable Use acknowledgement are retained for a period of up to seven (7) years.

8. Are cookies used in the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software?

We do not use cookies in the PwC Registration System.

9. Sale of Business

This Privacy Statement discusses PricewaterhouseCoopers' information practices in the ordinary course of its business. PricewaterhouseCoopers may and reserves the right to transfer all data in its possession to a successor-in-interest to its business or assets.

10. Links to third party sites

The PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software may provide a number of third party links to relevant reference sites. No personally identifying information is transferred from the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software to such reference sites, and such reference sites are not subject to this PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software Privacy Statement. We assume no responsibility for any information collected by or other practices of those sites and encourage users to review each site's privacy statement before disclosing any personally identifiable information.

11. Changes to the PricewaterhouseCoopers registration software Privacy Statement

PricewaterhouseCoopers reserves the right to change this privacy statement at any time. The effective date of the statement will be displayed at the beginning of the statement. Please refer back to the statement periodically to review any updates.
